Our member governments are Little Pine First Nation, Lucky Man Cree Nation, Moosomin First Nation, Saulteaux First Nation, Sweetgrass First Nation, the City of North Battleford, and the Town of Battleford.

WHAT IS THE “SHARING A VISION” PROJECT?

The "Sharing a Vision" project will explore opportunities for Indigenous and non-Indigenous participation through a series of regional community conversations about:

- Health care
- Education and;
- Recreation

The “Sharing the Vision” Project is seeking to engage with each of the BRCC member communities between March 2023 and April 2023 to get feedback on these important issues. The project outcome will summarize existing and ideal conditions for each issue, based on the community feedback and will provide suggestions for planning pathways.

The survey is an opportunity for area residents to share their views on the state of education, health and recreation services in the Battlefords. This community engagement will help the BRCC to identify gaps and determine priority areas in its efforts to improve local services.
